Criteria

- Open to Edon, Edgerton, Montpelier, or Bryan high school graduating students
- Preference given to someone studying manufacturing skilled trades, machine operation, CNC Programming, CAD/CAM, Manufacturing Technology or Forestry/Forestry Management
- May attend a 2- or 4-year college, university, or trade school

STEP 3

Submit Application

DEADLINE: February 28, 2025

- 1. Print the application
- 2. **IMPORTANT** Student and Parent signatures required (Section E)
- 3. Submit application and an original copy of your senior picture to your guidance counselor
- 4. Counselor must fill in the academic information and provide signature and date (Section A)
